- ARPA funds mitigated ongoing cuts to the field, but as these expire in 2025, victims are left standing on the edge of a financial cliff.

## \$8.25M NEEDED TO STABILIZE VICTIM SERVICES

A total combined state and federal investment of \$27.75M is the goal to preserve vital services in every community across Virginia.
